

# THE 3<sup>rd</sup> EVENT, (First)

## Or “Whadda Ya’ Mean the Road Changed?”

April 13, 2003

The first rally of the Finger Lakes Region 2003 Spring Rally Series, THE 3<sup>rd</sup> EVENT, (First), was a course following rally starting and ending at Cheap Charlie’s in Bloomfield, NY. With temperatures in the 50’s and a few high thin clouds, the views of adjoining hilltops and valleys were spectacular. Radio controlled model airplanes provided entertainment at check point #2. Everyone agreed that the drive was worth seeing.

Route instructions featured both numbered and lettered instructions. Numbered instructions defined the course to follow and were done in order and at the mileage given. Those distances were founded to the closest tenth based on the official mileages used in the passage time calculations. Lettered instructions gave speed changes, pauses, cautions and odometer rezeros. They became active after the previous numbered instruction was reached and could be repeated until cancelled.

Five of the 76 miles covered by the rally were on unpaved roads. The paved roads varied in quality and markings. Speeds varied based on the road surface and markings, with unpaved roads run at 30 mph and paved roads with both center and edge markings run at 40 or 45 mph. Some center line and edge stripes were very difficult to see.

The answer to ten questions could be found along the way. Each correct answer reduced the score by 5% of the value received if that question had not been answered.

The scoring has been recalculated to correct for errors made at the scoring table. The results are given below.
