

Meeting called to order by RE at 7:30 PM

National news - runoff are complete and you can watch every race on SCCA.com. We had four members at the event, Greg and Sandy Hopkins and Russell Jaslow worked the event and John Weisberg competed. The 2026 Runoffs® are going to be at Road America.

We have race dates for next year. The Glen Region Divisional is scheduled for the weekend after Memorial Day, May 30th-31st. The Hoosier Super Tour is scheduled for June 19th-21st and Fun One is scheduled for September 19th-20th. We will be putting on the Super Tour this year.

The 2025 Fun One held the 1st Time Trails event at WGI and there were 23 entries. Finances are not final for the Fun One and TT yet. For future considerations TT would like a dedicated group, dedicated Stewards and registration, want to open registration 90 days prior to the event and they would want their own webpage etc. Their requests and the cost of track time make it unrealistic to have another event at WGI.

We are looking at having Formula Vee's again next year, as well as adding big bores and S2000's.
