

Membership minutes May 5, 2026

Meeting called to order at 7:34 PM by Secretary Mike Toombs

Regional Executive Charlie Tanck was not able to make the meeting.

Membership – Barbara reported that we have 446 members, with seven new members. Membership picnic is July 28 at Camp Eastman with Colby Catering supplying the dinner.

There were 10 to 12 submissions for the new region logo. Region board selected one supplied by Tyler Porter as it reflected the history of the club and its motorsport heritage. We are looking for a printer to get some stickers printed up.

Racing – Super Tour registration opened April 19, so far we have 39 drivers with 46 entries; one driver has entered three cars. Garages are going fast.

Marl Krueger reported that there has been two Solo events so far. The first event had 82 entries on a rather cold Sunday. The second event had 120 entries. The Startling Line School on Saturday the 25th of April had 22 entries.

May 9th there is an additional Test and Tune with over 30 entries so far.

There may not be a Road Rally meeting this month as they are working on STPR. A schedule is being worked on for the 2027-2028 Winter Rally Series.

Chris Bucknam reported there are monthly STPR meetings. There is a hope of an additional major sponsor for the event. The event is on the schedule for July 9-11. Pretty much the same course as last year, worker registration is open.

There are 30 driver registered for the Glen Region Time Trials the end of May.

Chris Bucknam is looking at some changes that maybe needed for the by-laws. He is also looking at getting a nominating committee together to put together a slate of candidates for next the election in December. Charlie Tanck has been the Regional Executive for the past 12 years and he has stated he will not be running again.

Chris is going to Bruce Perry's place to look at cleaning out of the region RallyCross trailer. After it is cleaned out, we hope to look at selling the trailer.
