Meeting call to order by Charlie Tanck 7:30 PM

NEDiv meeting was at Scranton, PA. President Cobb was there as well as three other National Office people. Mike Cobb commented that there was concern that the SCCA would not survive the covid year. There are only 8 race regions in NEDiv that are still racing. With the increase of track costs it is getting tough to break even. South Jersey canceled Majors race at Pocono this year because of potential losses.

Last year there was less than 500 entries for RunOffs® last year. Race registrations are currently up for this year.

Banquet went over well, 40 people where there.

Race - working on the Supps for the Super Tour. SCCA support for regional racing is non-existent. Charlie ordered tech stickers, didn't get entire order, National has stopped selling stickers and gave us credit for undelivered stickers.

Solo has issues getting the right cones. Shipping is the greatest cost, region shouldn't need any this year. National office is cutting down on the equipment they supply to National Tour event and rely on the region to supply required equipment.
